



The Pantry



Move out of current location and into former Gunrock Gaming. Add refrigeration, freezer, office space, shelving, receiving, covered awnings, moveable equipment and branding. Adding 350+ of space and will move to a traditional marketplace shopping experience

- Estimated completion date Spring 2024



CoHo

Expansion CoHo West toward Wellman Hall.

Expand Coffee House seating with outdoor patio, add student employee break room, office space, changing space and meeting room. Redo restrooms to be gender inclusive.

- Estimated Cost \$6.5M
- Funding Sources
 - CoHo CEI Funds \$2M,
 - Memorial Union Safety Fee \$2.5M
 - ASUCD Reserves \$2M
- Estimated completion dateSummer 2025.



KDVS 90.3FM

KDVS out of Lower Freeborn and move into TB24 North Side (EcoHub)

- Estimated cost \$1.8M
 - Funding sources
 - Student Affairs \$1.3 \$1.8M
 - ASUCD Reserves earmarked for \$500,000
 - Estimated completion Fall 2024

Radio Tower Move

- Estimated cost unknown
 - Funding sources
 - ASUCD Reserves earmarked \$250,000
 - Estimated completion date 2028





Campus Center for the Environment



Provide more accessible and safe parking for ASUCD garden and to extend the life-expectancy of the shipping container and make it more accessible.

- Estimated cost \$250,000 \$300,000
 - Funding sources
 - ASUCD Reserves
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2024/ Winter 2025



Bike Barn



New Rental Bike Parking and redesign of Showroom Floor

- Install bike racks on concrete footers in gravel area and install a cordon barrier to match existing area around Bike Barn perimeter
- Estimated cost \$25,000
 - Funding sources
 - ASUCD Reserves
 - Estimated completion date Summer 2024
 - Showroom floor is TBD Estimated completion 2026





Unitrans

Demolish the current undersized administrative office building at Unitrans Operations and Maintenance Facility rebuild as a two story, larger administrative office building which would allow all Unitrans staff to be housed at the facility.

- Estimated project cost \$8.5M
- Funding Sources
 - Unitrans formula funding and fees \$6.5M
 - ASUCD Reserves earmark \$2M
 - Estimated Completion date 2026/2028
