



# Need & Goals

The Academic Retention Initiatives launched in 2015, however, the Asian and Pacific Islander (AandPI) Retention Initiative was not established until 2019.

Within the last 6 years, the percentage of AandPI Male Identifying students in Academic Recovery has stay consistently the same.

With the campus wide Men of Color Success Initiative newly implemented in 2024, it provides an opportunity to launch an intentional program tailored to uplift our AandPI Male identifying students.
