Sport Clubs & Intramural Sport Programs.

3. Please provide information on any substantial variance between 2020-21 and 2021-22:

Student wages budgeted for 2021-22 adjusted back to the fully operating employment level to the amount of approximately \$38,000. This reflects both the minimum wage increase in addition to the increased students needed to operate programs and facilities relative to the closure due to the pandemic year. Also, this increase reflects the student staffing required for three new sport clubs added in fiscal year 2021-22. Program expenses/sport club allocations adjusted to a fully operational level amounting to approximately \$142,000 in 2021-22.

Ending reserves for Fiscal Year 2020-21 were \$972,906 to contribute to the cost of replacing the turf for Dairy Field, estimated at over \$1 million.

- 6. Please describe the need for a consumer price index (CPI) adjustment and include the departmental plan if CPI is not applied next academic year.**

The CPI adjustment is being requested to cover the increase to student wages as a result of the minimum wage increase and continue to contribute to reserves for the renewal of Dairy Field Turf. Sport Clubs has also taken on two new sport clubs which is increasing student staff time. If not approved, Campus Recreation will need to reevaluate service levels and maintain the current level of allocations to stay within the available funds.

- 7. Is there information this department would like to provide regarding the scope of student use of the programs/services/facilities funded by CEI?**

The Sport Club programs consist of 41 clubs (previously 39). This year we added on E-Sports and Swim Club, two very popular clubs. We allocate 20-25% of each club's total costs, as well as employ 45 students and 50 volunteers as referees and sport club managers. Additional expenses have been added in order to accommodate COVID-19 protocols.
