Reserve level at 2016/17 fiscal close was \$2,173,401. Capital improvements planned for this coming year include replacement of aging equipment (Refrigerators, Ice Machine, Hot Storage units, Coffee Grinder, etc.) per Coffee House Equipment Replacement Plan, as well as a small renovation of the Chopstixx service platform to facilitate menu growth. The Coffee House leadership is also interested in examining the long-term viability of utilizing reserves to expand the dining room, renovate/expand the employee area (backpack/shoe storage and restrooms/changing rooms) and/or renovate the customer restrooms.

A CPI adjustment will allow the Coffee House to maintain its facility and equipment as costs continually increase year to year. Not approving a CPI adjustment could lead to a limiting of funds available for planned improvements and an inability for the fund to support the CoHo's efforts to innovate and expand its services to meet the growing campus needs.
