RE: Campus Based Fees for 2024-25

Dear VC Reguerín and VC Shinnerl,

The Council on Student Affairs and Fees (COSAF) spent this year evaluating budgets from departments across campus that are funded by campus-based fees, as well as the Student Services Fee. These reviews were conducted to assure appropriate use of fee revenue and to determine if a Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment is recommended, if eligible.

The attached document provided by Budget & Institutional Analysis reflects a comprehensive look at 2024-25 projected fees based on COSAF recommendations. The report includes recommended CPI adjustments for FACE & LEEAP departments: Campus Recreation, Student Recruitment & Retention Center, Intercollegiate Athletics and Law School Recruitment & Retention. Other recommended CPI adjustments include GSA Fee and all components of CEI; Student Community Center, Intercollegiate Athletics, Student Health and Counseling Services, ASUCD Coffee House, ASUCD Unitrans and Campus Recreation. Per referendum language, all recipients of SASI have an automatic CPI adjustment.

In addition, the council endorsed an extension of the **Safety Fee** beyond 2029, provided input on development of the **Student Affairs Strategic Plan**, conducted a full review on the **Memorial Union Fee**, and provided an endorsement to place **The Green Initiative Fund (TGIF)** referendum on the spring 2024 election ballot.

Referring to page two, all proposed 2024-25 proposed fee increases are listed separately. Undergraduate students will see a proposed **\$90.48** total increase in campus-based fees. Graduate/professional students will see a proposed **\$35.26** increase in campus-based fees and the proposed increase for Law students' campus-based fees is **\$32.06**.

We are currently writing the annual report which will further detail the activities of the 2023-24 council and include detailed COSAF recommendations, feedback on five **Student Services Fee** department presentations and allocations of \$100,000 in **Student Programming Funds**. We hope you will find these recommendations useful to Student Affairs and Finance, Operations and Administration in its efforts to create a positive and meaningful campus experience for every student at UC Davis.
