Student Programming Funds Background

Eligibility

All campus units that provide co-curricular student services and support for student groups are eligible to apply for **ONE-TIME** funding from the <u>Council on Student Affairs and Fees (COSAF)</u>.

The maximum amount of discretionary funding COSAF can recommend for the 2024-25 school year is \$100,000.

Allocation Priorities

- Services and Programs of Growing Interest to Students
- Programs that Provide Crucial Services to Students
- Student Services and Programs Fostering Diversity, Equity and Inclusion
- Programs and Activities that Benefit a Large Range of the Student Population

COSAF Review

- In Fall 2023, the Council on Student Affairs and Fees (COSAF) created a subcommittee, comprised of Undergraduate student members and a Staff Advisor, to review applications for 2024-25 funding
- Applications were open from 8/1/23 through 2/12/14
- 18 applications met the Allocation Priorities and were approved for presentations to the council in spring quarter 2024
- Presentations took place on 3/8/24 and 4/5/24
- Total amount requested: \$242,840
- Following presentations, the full council completed a Qualtrics survey to provide feedback for the subcommittee to consider when deliberating allocations
