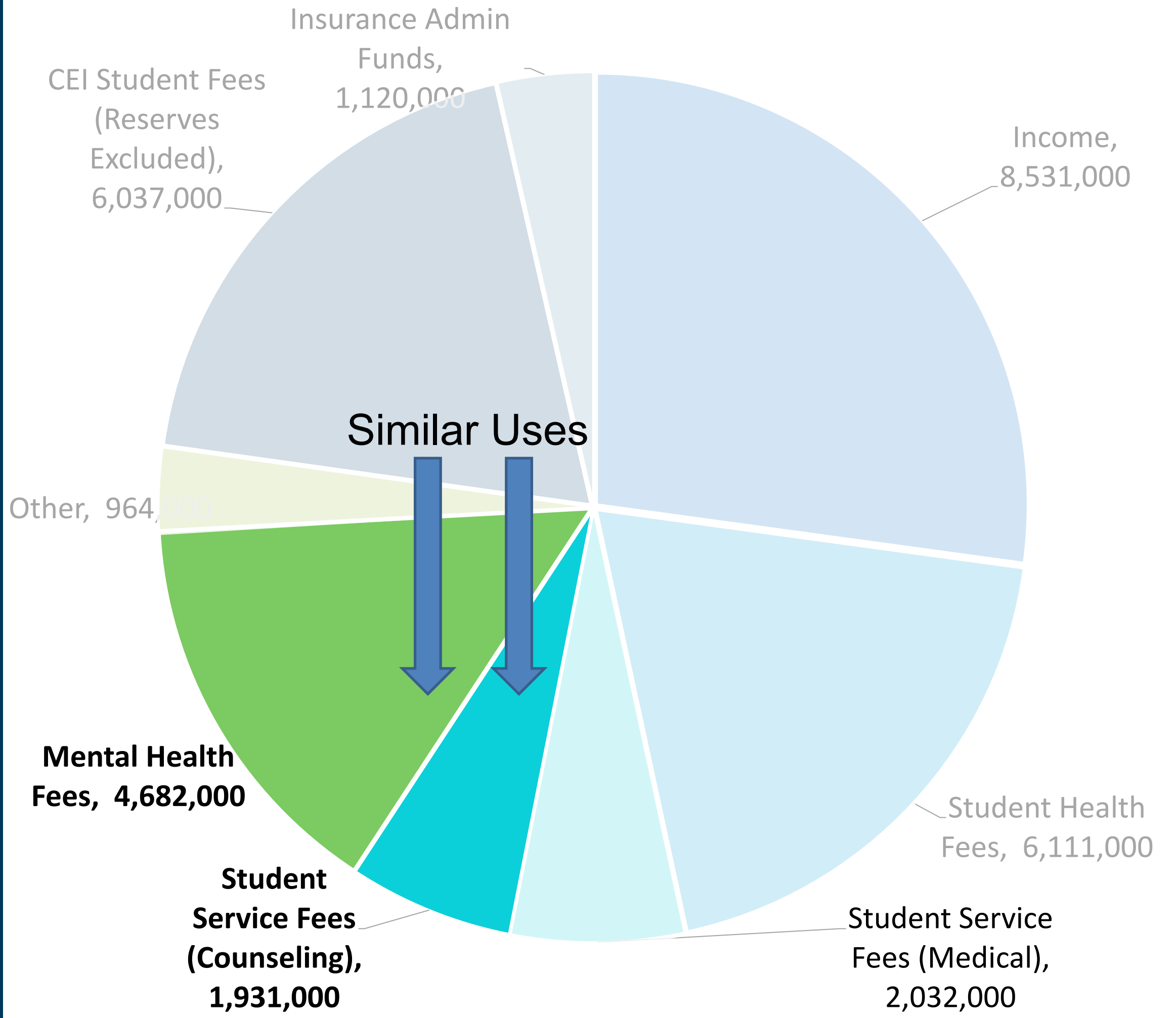

SSF Success 2021-22

- **Mental Health Recruitments**
 - Expansion of Psychiatry Department
 - Counseling Services recruitments
 - 19 licensed counselors hired since August 2021
 - Currently 37 FTE with 7 open positions
- **Medical Recruitments**
 - Primary Care Providers
 - Medical Assistants

SSF Success: Public Health Branch

- On March 15, 2022, Provost Mary Croughan sent SHCS a formal letter of approval for the new SHCS Public Health Branch.
 - I will provide \$690,000 annually in one-time funding for three years to support the following positions: **Infection Control Physician, Public Health Coordinator, and Public Health Nurse.**
 - and
 - I will provide \$400,000 ongoing funding for **two additional Registered Nurses.** While these positions will be available to support public health needs, I anticipate they also will be essential to meeting broader needs within SHCS.

SSF Success: Public Health Branch

- The SHCS Public Health Unit was established to better coordinate prevention efforts, patient care and campus response to infectious diseases and other public health issues.
 - Launched the first clinic in Yolo County to offer both MPOX vaccines and diagnosis and treatment
 - Continue to offer COVID-19 testing and treatment
