As of June 30, 2020, there were 805 Registered Student Organizations (RSOs), and two councils or boards engaged with the Center for Student Involvement (CSI). These various organizations serve undergraduate, graduate, and professional school students at both the Davis and Health campus. Based on CSI's AggieLife* data the total number of self-reported members in all 805 RSOs was 16,431. The number of unique students on RSO rosters was 11,092, which represents 28% of all enrolled students.
