Committee	Description	Meeting Frequency
<p>Health Fee Oversight Committee HFOC</p>	<p>Approved by student referendum, a health fee was established in 1996 to assist in funding of UC Davis SHCS Medical Services.</p> <p>The Health Fee Oversight Committee (HFOC) makes recommendations for changes in the health fee and types of services the health fee supports. This committee is advisory to the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and the Student Health and Counseling Director. Members are appointed for one-year terms by the Vice Chancellor.</p>	<p>The HFOC generally meets once each quarter for 2 hours, with additional meetings scheduled as necessary.</p>
<p>Student Health Insurance Plan Committee SHIP</p>	<p>The SHIP Committee was formed to provide broad campus involvement in the maintenance and development of the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP), and provide informed advice to the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs regarding SHIP.</p> <p>The Committee endeavors to provide a health insurance plan that best meets the essential medical needs of most students at an affordable price. It recognizes that exceptional medical needs for a small number of students may be better met by alternative health plans. Students, university administration, and faculty are represented on the Committee.</p>	<p>The SHIP committee generally meets for 1-2 hours, approximately once a quarter, with additional meetings scheduled as necessary.</p>
<p>The Green Initiative Fund Committee TGIF</p>	<p>The Green Initiative Fund (TGIF) Committee consists of a majority of undergraduate members, who steward the TGIF grant fund.</p> <p>The TGIF Committee reads and evaluates submitted grant proposals and deliberates awards; provides guidance and project management oversight to funded projects; conducts campus outreach to spread word of TGIF funds; works with the TGIF Grant Manager to administer the TGIF funds; and works in subcommittees and conducts weekly full committee meetings during the academic year to accomplish the work of the Committee.</p> <p>For 2024-25: Returning member, Caspar Schulte, will serve as the representative from COSAF</p>	<p>The TGIF committee meets weekly. Additional time is spent outside of meetings for application review. The COSAF member sitting on this committee is designated as an Undergraduate.</p>
