3. Please provide information on any substantial variance between 2019-20 and 2020-21:

We anticipate some reduced costs for UC Davis Health Stadium due to likelihood of no fans throughout the 2020-21 season. Additionally, custodial costs will increase significantly as we transition from a 3rd party vendor to using campus custodial services. Grounds costs by facility have also been updated after a thorough review of needs, resulting in reduced costs for Schaal and Stadium.

5.	If applicable, please provide plans for use of reserves listed in section #2:
	For 2020-21, we anticipate modest use of reserves for both the Stadium and Schaal. We do anticipate significant expenditures in 2021-22 of over \$2M, including \$950K for turf replacement and \$1.2M for pool/pool deck replastering.
2	Projects in 2020-21 include: Stadium: upgrading HVAC system (\$50K), practice field turf replacement (\$25K), repainting of railings and stairs (\$35K), and replacing the tunnel gate (\$15K). Schaal: Schaal expansion (\$64K), security cameras (\$15K), replace lane lines (\$10K), replace pool covers (\$9K)
6.	Please describe the need for a consumer price index (CPI) adjustment and include the departmental plan if CPI is not applied next academic year.
	Many of the annual increases related to facility expenses, such as grounds, utilities, and custodial, as well as salary and benefit costs, generally exceed the CPI rate. A lack of CPI increase will result in the inability to maintain the facilities to adequate standards without dipping into the reserves; having a prudent reserve is important to ensure that all major maintenance issues can be addressed.
7.	Is there information this department would like to provide regarding the scope of student use of the programs/services/facilities funded by FACE/LEEAP? (Please limit your response to those items funded by FACE/LEEAP.)
	These two facilities provide both competitive and entertainment opportunities for all students. PE, intramurals and club programs use the facilities on a regular basis. The university is discontinuing PE after fall quarter and we are working to develop some participation opportunities hosted by ICA coaches.
