Dear Larry:

At its May 2002 meeting, the Board of Regents amended *Standing Order 100.4g-- Duties of the President*, delegating authority to the President to set fee levels for compulsory student fees adopted by student referenda, including student-fee-funded facilities and summer charges for these fees.

Consistent with that delegation, I am approving an increase of \$20 per semester to the existing Law Student Association Fee. Revenue from the fee increase will provide increased support to the operating budget for the Law Student Association General Fund. The fee increase is effective fall 2007. The additional funds will help support and improve the variety of events currently supported by the Association, as well as broaden the scope of events and services that can be offered. The fee increase was approved by students through a referendum conducted during winter 2007, consistent with campus voting requirements. Consistent with University policy, 25 percent of the revenue generated from the fee increase will be used for student financial aid. My approval is based on the recommendation submitted by your campus.

The Law Student Association (LSA) is a non-profit organization that provides a variety of services to law students. The LSA has been successful in raising funds to support these services, but it needs to supplement its revenue to continue to provide the same level of service. The LSA is requesting that the Board of Regents approve a compulsory student fee of \$100 per student per year. This fee will be used to support the LSA's operations and to fund a variety of programs and services. The LSA is confident that this fee will be well received by law students and that it will help to ensure the continued success of the Law Student Association.

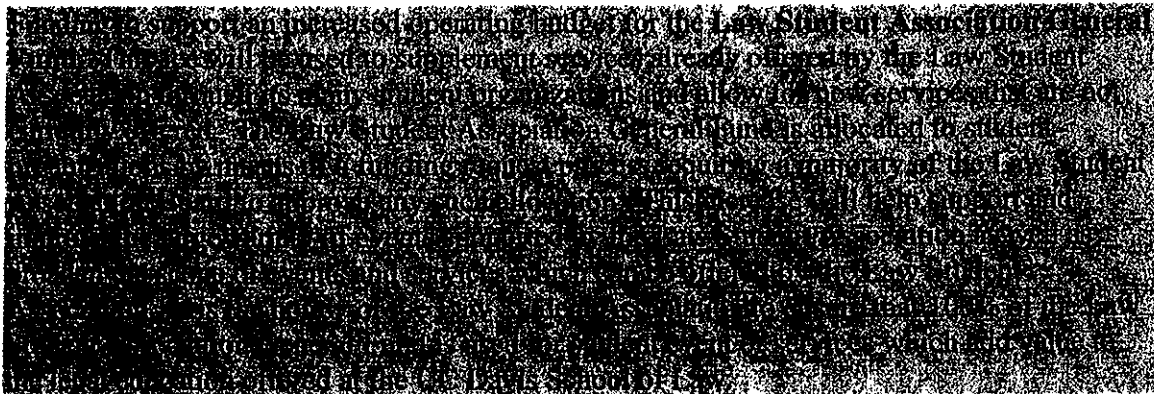



Dear Chancellor Vanderhoef:

This is to request your approval of the Law Student Association Fee voted on in a law student election. I am satisfied that the election was consistent with the requirements specified in the UC Davis Policy & Procedure Manual – Section 280-15, particularly related to the referendum and ballot language, the educational campaign for voters and adherence to the voting specifications of policy. In addition, the terms and conditions of the referendum are fully compliant with UC Policy 80.0 (Compulsory-Based Student Fees) in its most current, approved form including adherence to the requirement for Return to Aid, in which 25% of the total new fee must be provided.

A total of 362 votes were received, which is equivalent to 63% of the number of law students eligible to vote in the election. This number exceeds the 20% minimum requirement for campus-based fees set forth in policy. 272 voted (79%) in favor of the increase, while 74 (21%) opposed, thus exceeding the majority approval rate required. Of the 362 votes in the general election, 16 students chose not to vote on this particular measure.

I recommend your acceptance and approval of this referendum which provides funding to increase the operating budget for the Law Student Association to supplement services already offered and to allow for new services. The referendum also includes a Return to Aid component (25%) as required by UC policy.

Upon your approval, I ask that you also forward this request for approval to the President who has been delegated authority by The Regents to set fee levels for compulsory student fees adopted by student referenda (Standing Order 100.4 (g)). A draft approval letter to the President is attached.

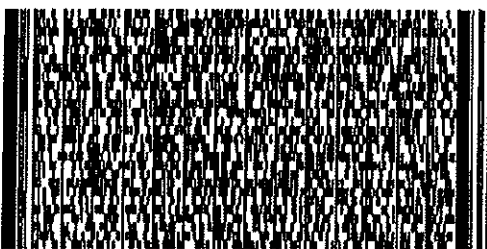

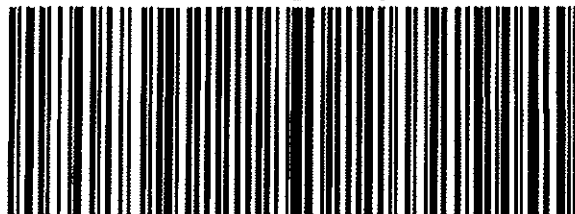

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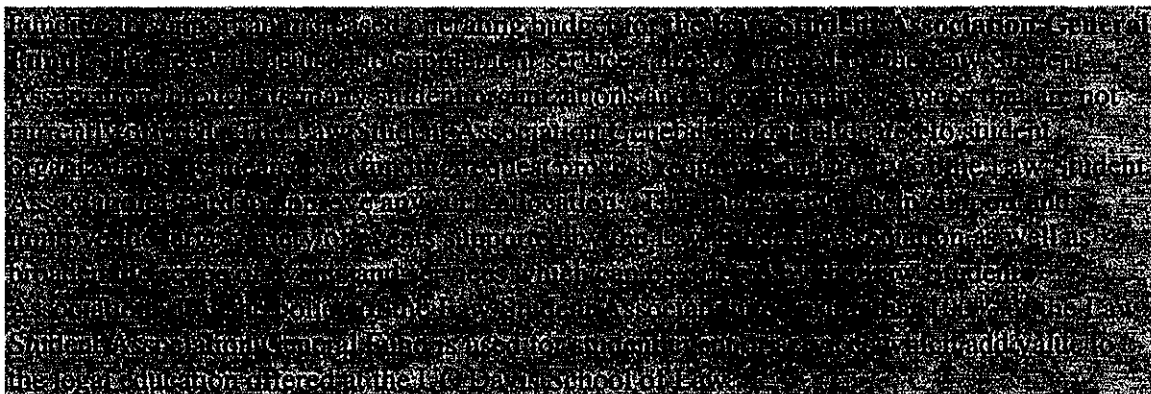
