Q. Calvin. You mentioned the Edward Family Athletic Center. I saw on your website that it is going to cost around \$52 million and that you paid \$51 million. Where are you getting that \$51 million from?

A. Rocko. That is part of our funding. We raised \$13 million of that, and with the partnership of UC Davis Health, they have contributed some of that and campus bought us out of our building at Cowell to form a Student Health Center on campus so we were going a trade for that building.

Q. Calvin. So are any student fees going to this?

A. Rock. No

Q. Calvin. Okay, what about the other \$1 million, where is that going to come from?

A. Rocko. We haven't updated that because we are still working on the fund raising. We have exceeded the goal, we just haven't updated it yet.

A. Rocko. We're hoping that's going to be 10 years.

Q. Calvin. The last time there was a game at this stadium how many of them were current students in the audience out of the community?

A. Rocko. The last game we played was over 5,000 students and probably about 7,000 community members.

Q. Calvin. What is the capacity of the stadium?

A. Rocko. That's a work in progress. If you look on our website it's 10,722 but there were over 11,000 last game and thanks to the berms there's a lot of room. For Eastern Washington in 4 weeks from now on the 13th of November and Sac State, those two games we're going to push the envelope as far as we can so we might get up to 13,000. Our team is 13th in the country right now. We've actually had record pre-sells.
