






SRRC Funding Sources 2021-2022



2021-22 Actuals




SRRC Expenses 2021-2022

- Increasing grant/funding opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students (e.g. collaborative programming, research grants, grad school application grants)






This event let me be connected with my own community. It brought me the feeling of home. I called my mom during the event and asked her for her recipes and that was such a healing experience for me.
