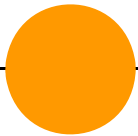

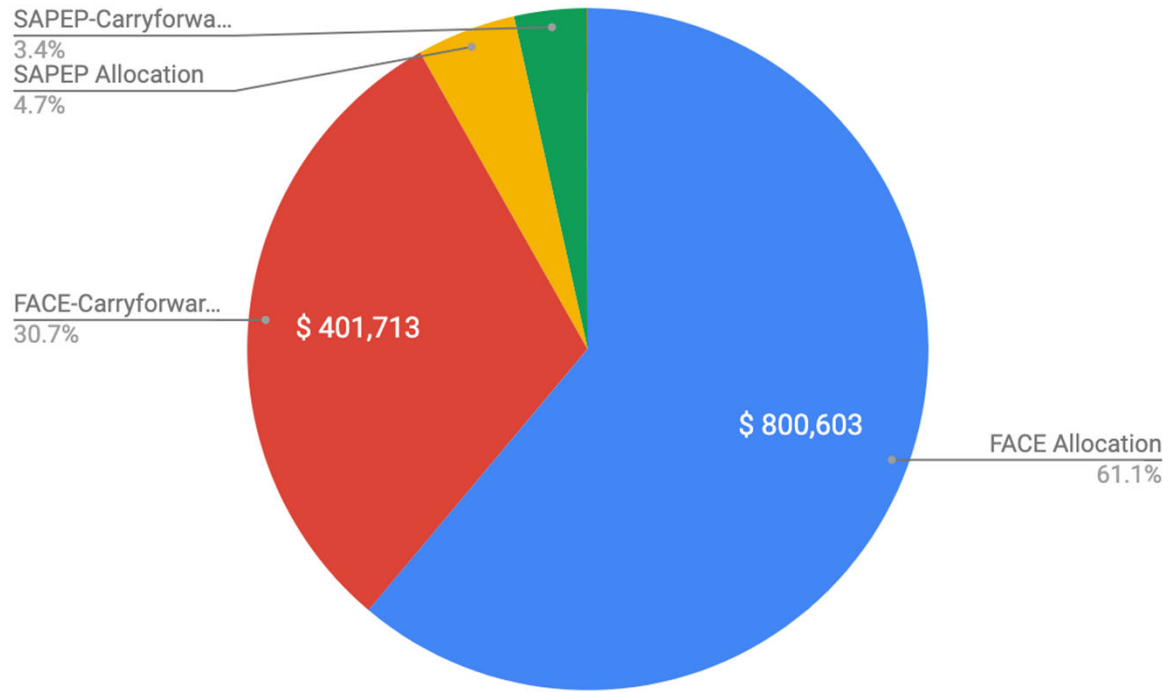

Our Budget

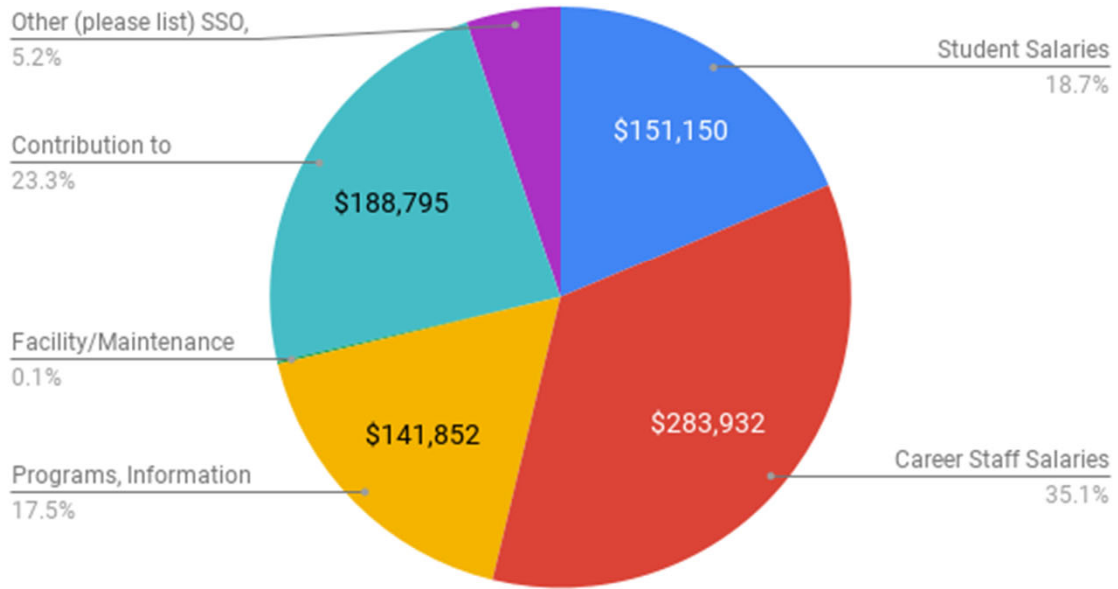


SRRC Funding Sources 2021-2022
