# Student Housing Insecurity

Data from the ASUCD-GSA Housing Affordability and Insecurity Survey 2017-2018

18% of UC Davis students surveyed experienced some form of housing insecurity.

7% of UC Davis students surveyed experienced homelessness.

UC GPA is highest for students who do not experience food or housing insecurity and lowest for those who do.




#### HOUSE LOGISTICS



### STUDENT VOLUNTEERS

- 45 student volunteers currently, hoping to reach 60-70 by opening.
- Executive Board + Director Board.
- Volunteers will sign-up for overnight shifts at the shelter in pairs 2-3 times per quarter.
  - Unlock the shelter.
  - Help prepare meals.
  - Maintain the shelter space.
  - Ensure that Aggie House is a safe & inclusive environment.
