18% of UC Davis students surveyed experienced some form of housing insecurity.

7% of UC Davis students surveyed experienced homelessness.

UC GPA is highest for students who do not experience food or housing insecurity and lowest for those who do.

Provide (4,320) meals to shelter residents annually



hours of case management to at-risk students annually

Provide **Aggie House residents** with shelter, food, case management services, permanent housing assistance, and community.




Empower and equip student volunteers to become leaders in social justice.




Serve as an **open source model** for future student-run shelters.

OUR FACILITY









HOUSE LOGISTICS

- 6 bedroom, 3 bathroom townhouse
- 10 resident capacity.
- Stay for up to 3 quarters (full academic year)
- Open daily 7:00pm 12:00pm plus allday on weekends





PARTNERSHIPS



- 2) Food breakfast & dinner daily.






• Medical case management Social case management

TRANSITION

Finding secure housing, Follow Up Basic Needs Assessment Survey

STUDENT VOLUNTEERS

- We currently have about 50–60 student volunteers who staff the shelter.
- Executive Board + Director Board.
- Volunteers will sign-up for overnight shifts at the shelter in pairs 2–3 times per quarter.
 - Unlock the shelter.
 - Help prepare meals.
 - Maintain the shelter space.
 - Ensure that Aggie House is a safe & inclusive environment.
