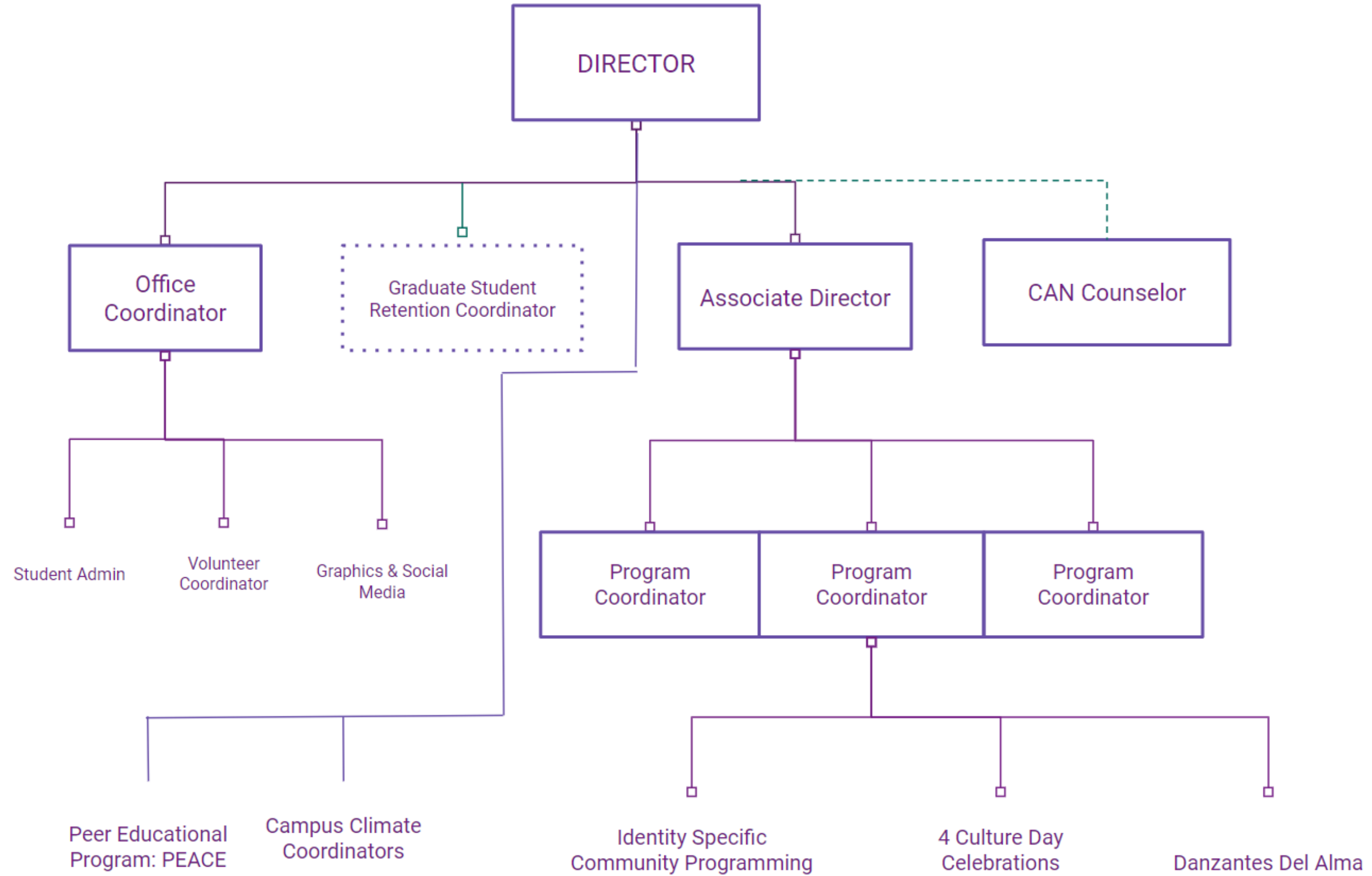

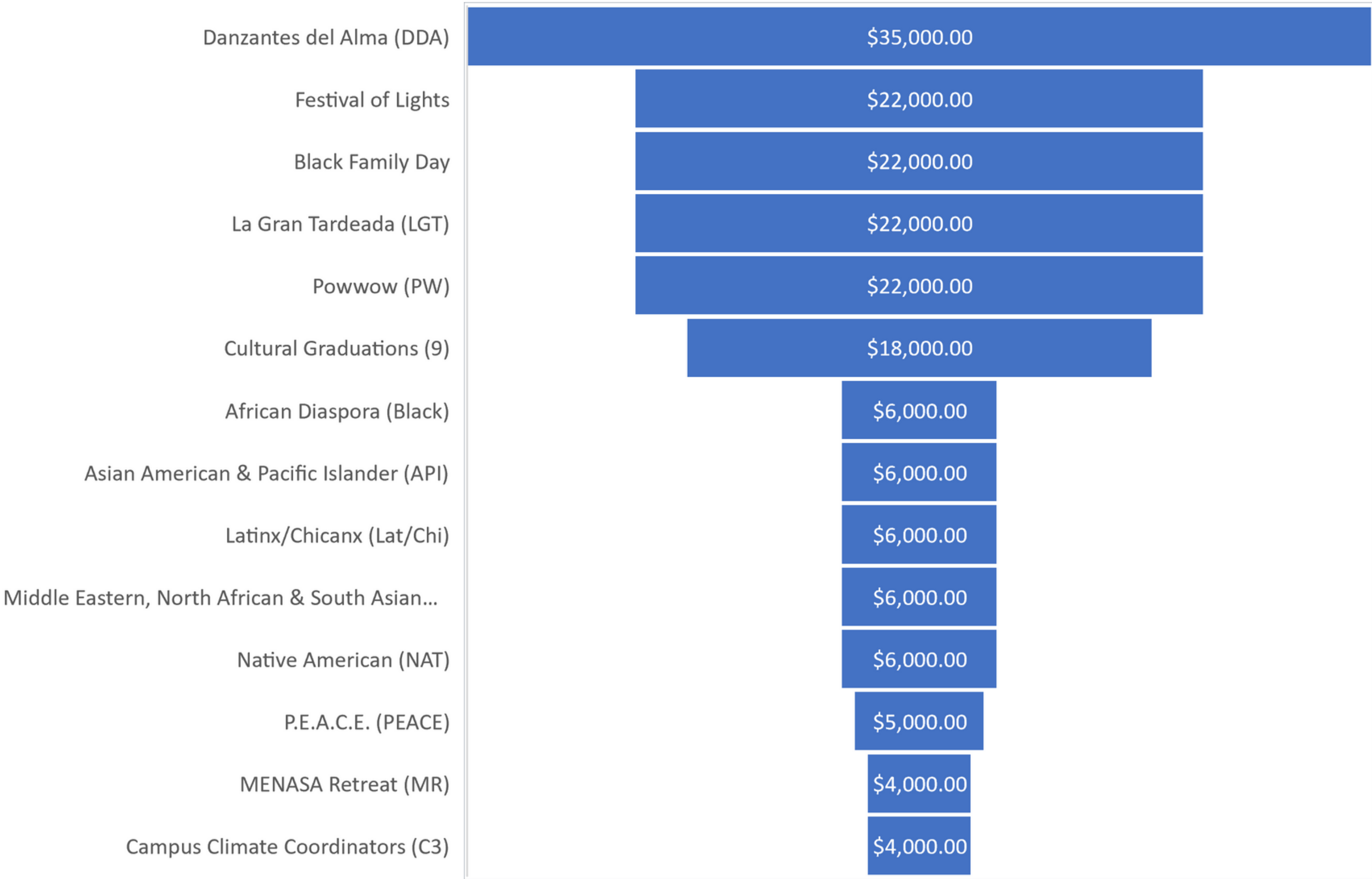

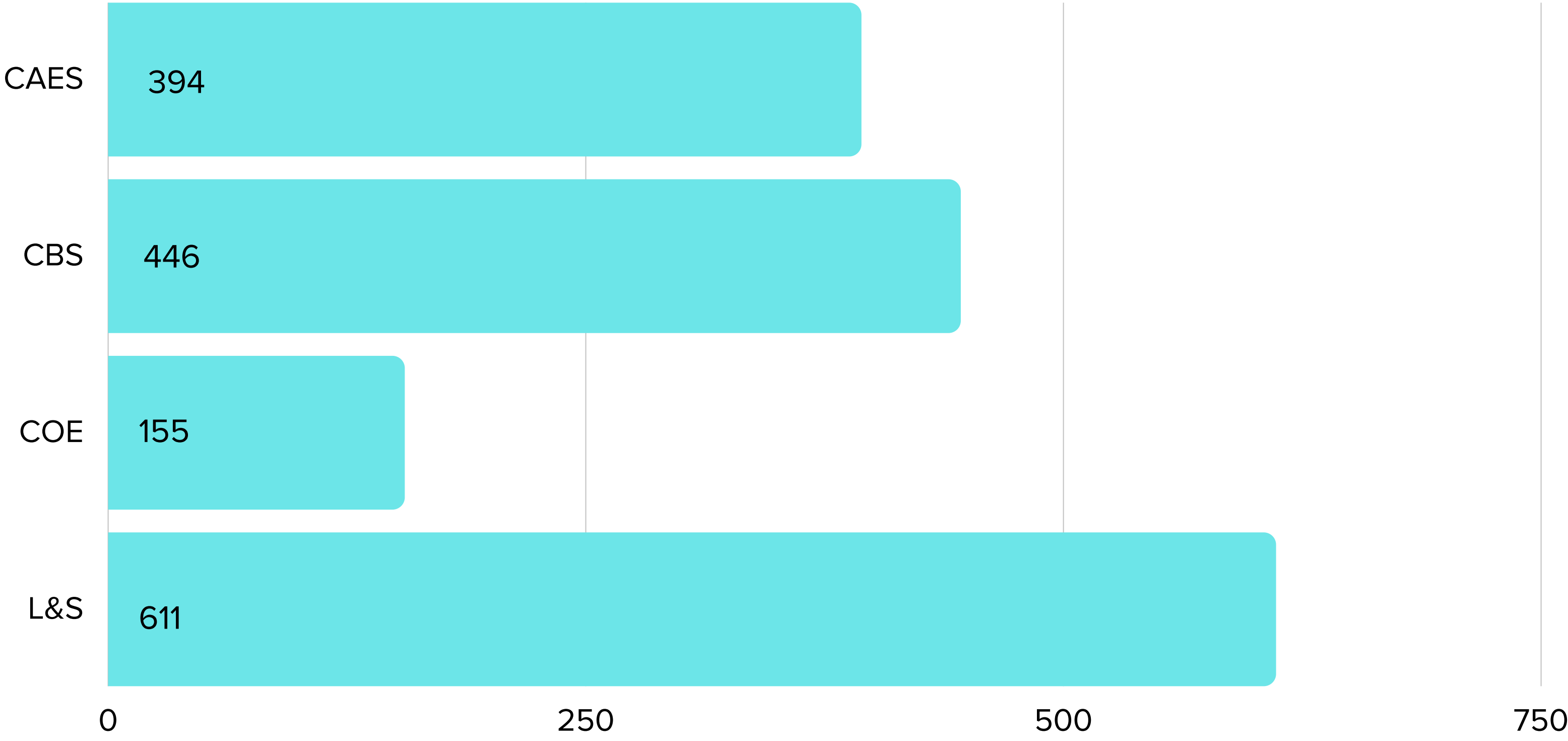

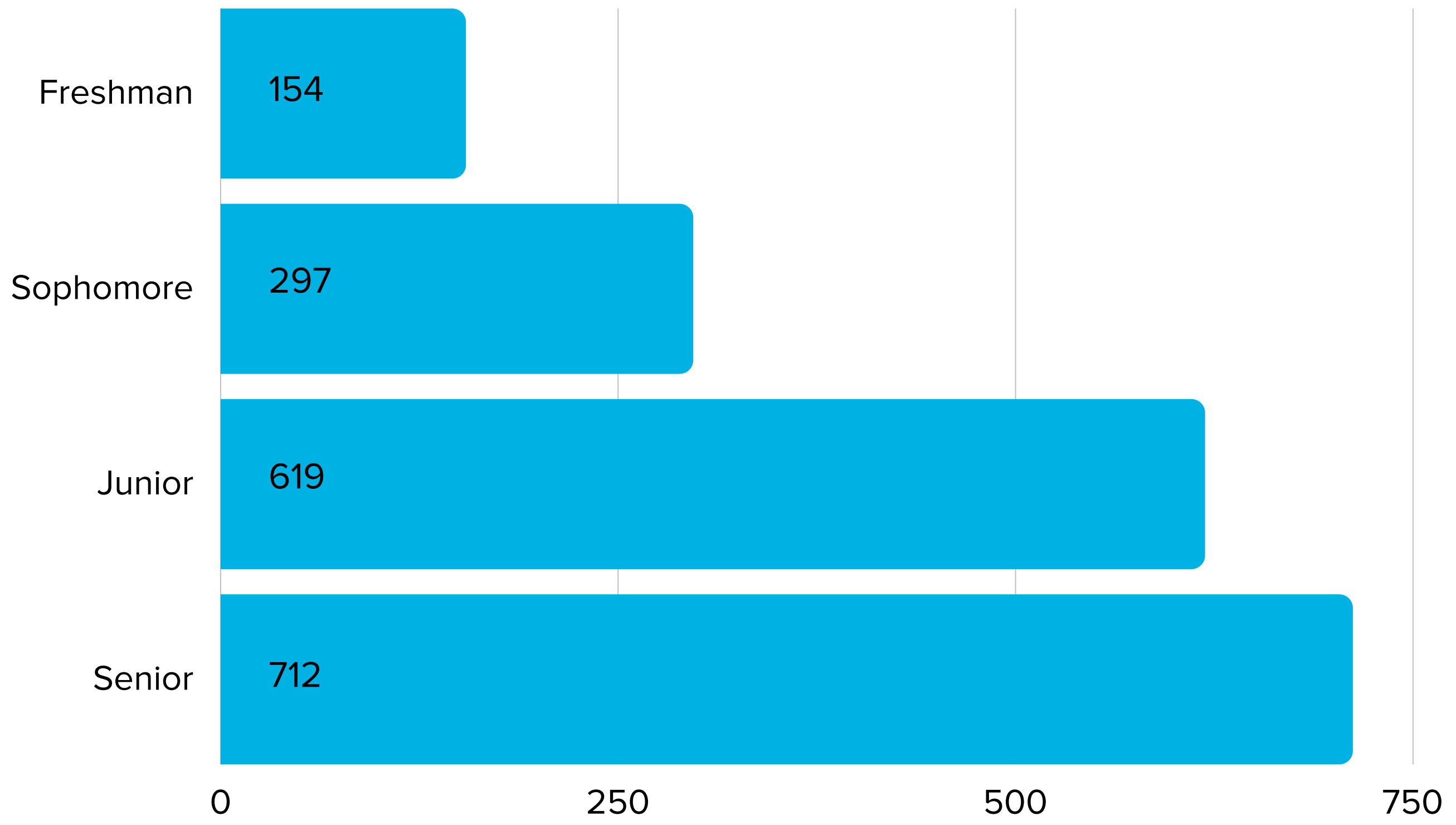

Students Served by College

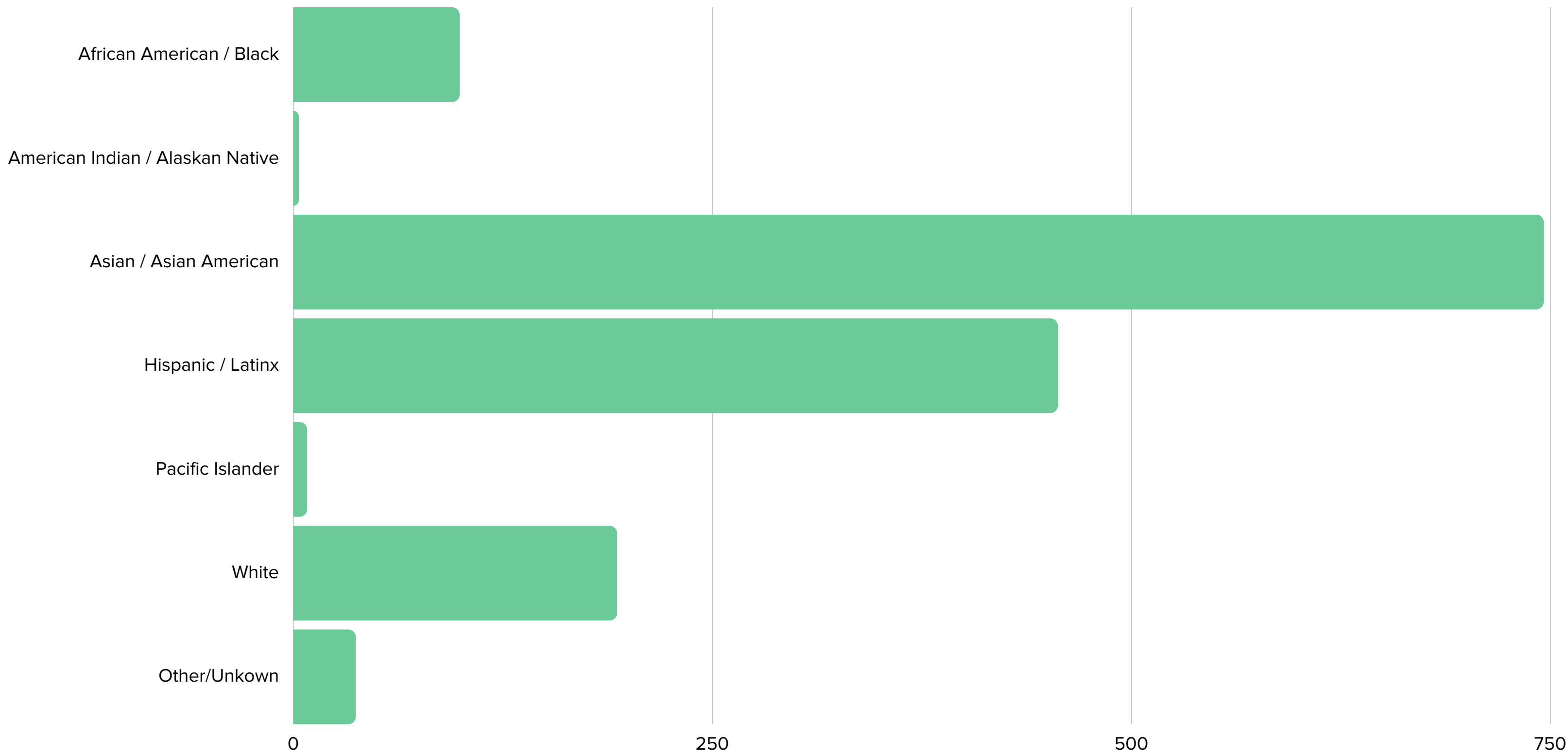


Students Served by Class Standing
