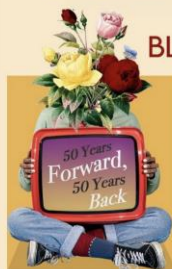

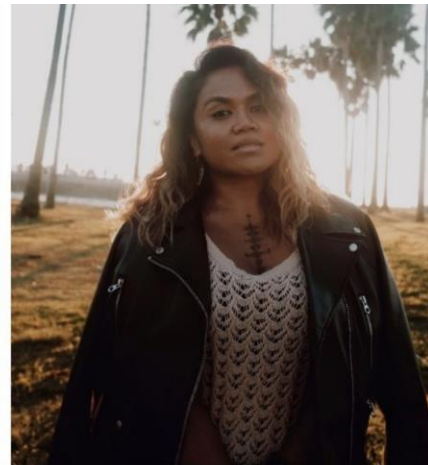



CCC Grant Request Form

The Cross-Cultural Center (CCC) Grants are funding for events, activities or programs that advance the institutional goal for campus diversity, and promote social justice. Grants are money that do not have to be returned and are given on the basis of application quality. UC Davis Registered Student Organizations (RSO) and UC Davis Campus Departments that apply for a grant may receive up to \$500 per year. Grants for RSOs and campus departments will be given in the form of reimbursements.

Organization/Department Grant Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be UC Davis affiliated
- Event/activity/program must align with one or more of the six values stated in the CCC's Mission Statement: advocacy, cultural competency, community building, educational excellence, identity exploration, and leadership development.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis.
