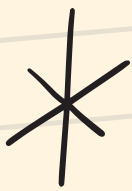

- Offers opportunity for leadership development for previous participants

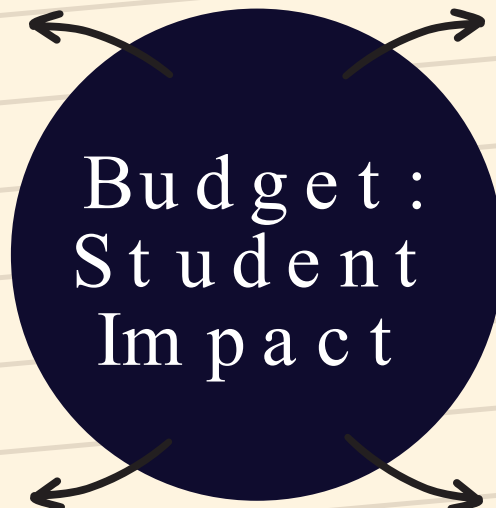


Books
