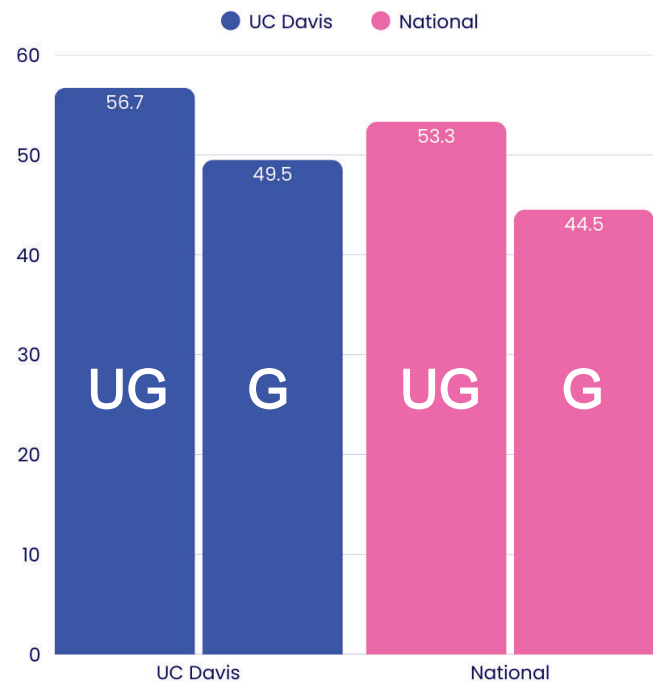

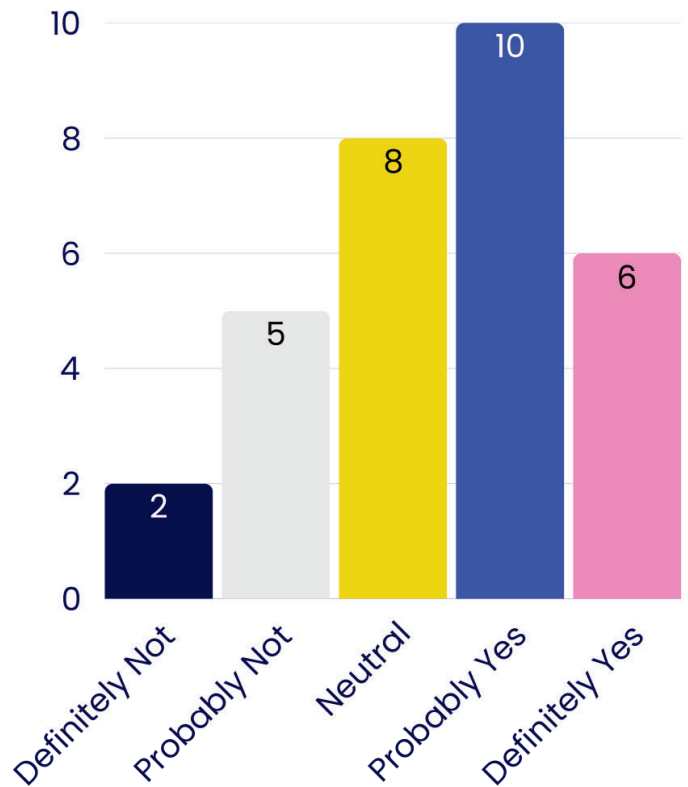
Of that 1/3, more than half require dues of \$20+ per quarter or ~\$60 per year.



Approximately one-third of the clubs sampled require dues

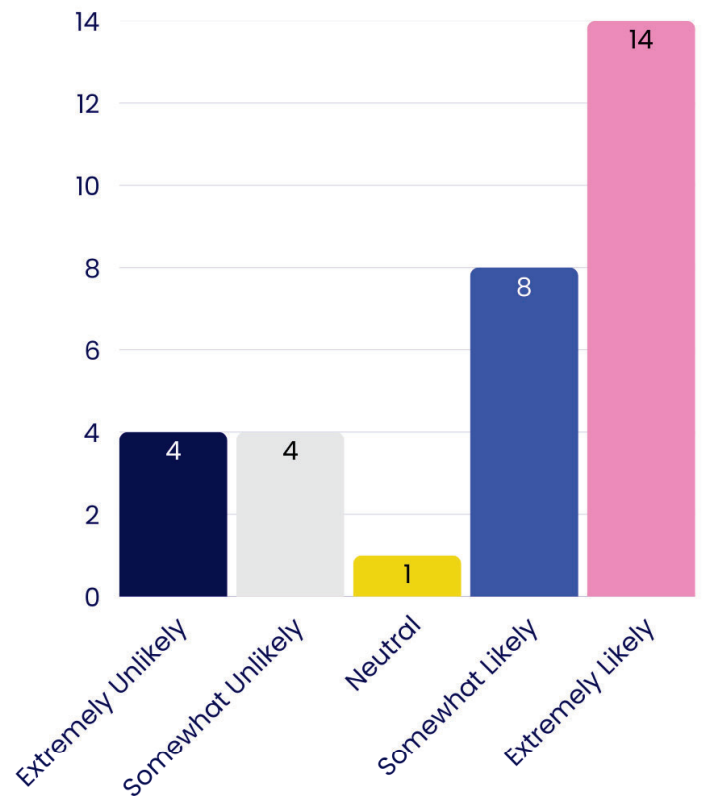
STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

How likely are you to use a fund that helps cover your club membership?



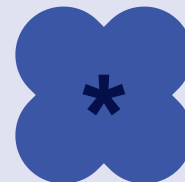
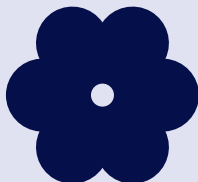
Brief Overview of Fee Waiver

Target Audience:

- UC Davis undergrad & grad students
- Students who have not joined clubs yet
- Low income
- Unrepresented/ historically marginalized background

Application Considerations:

- Minimum 2.8 GPA
- Students from low income or underrepresented backgrounds
- Joining organizations that promote inclusivity



BUDGET

Assuming the average club fee is around \$25, the fee could support approximately 200 students

EVALUATION PLAN

Process

- Number of students that receive grants
- Average amount of grant given

Impact

- Pre and post evaluation to measure involvement and sense of belonging

- Biannual Aggie Health and Well-Being Survey
