Financial Audit Procedures



NCAA Division 1 institutions are required to submit financial data detailing operating revenues, expenses, and capital related to its intercollegiate athletics program to the NCAA on an annual basis. This financial data is subject to agreed-upon procedures performed by a qualified independent accountant.

With the assistance of Accounting & Financial Reporting, ICA provides approximately 30 documents to the 3rd party auditor annually plus 100 revenue and expense samples for testing.


Intercollegiate Athletics Revenue (Sources)





ICA Participation Opportunities

- Over 650 student-athletes | 61% female student-athletes
- ICA continues to provide participation opportunities equivalent to campus enrollment

ICA Women's Head Coaches (2022-23)

- 63% of UC Davis head coaches were women (10 of 16 positions)
- National average for women head coaches was 42%

Increased Women Sport Assistant Coach Salaries

- In FY24, ICA increased women sport full-time assistant coach salaries
- 11% increase

Locker Room/Team Rooms

- Renovated old track offices into team room for track, cross country and beach volleyball
- Installed upgraded lockers in Hickey Women's Locker Room for use by studentathletes
