### The Future of TGIF

The TGIF student fee ratified in 2016 expired in Spring 2021. TGIF fee is currently (AY 21-22) *not* being collected.

## Referendum Renewal Attempted Spring 2021

Outcome

- 20% participation threshold required 7.17%; NOT ACHIEVED
- Majority "Yes" votes 67% Yes; ACHIEVED

## TGIF Fee Renewal Reinstatement Spring 2021 Fall 2022 Election

- Simplified and reduced scaled increase schedule
- Summary of new TGIF Fee Referendum:

#### Increase to \$3.50 quarterly TGIF fee, effective AY 2023-24

- Increase quarterly fee by \$0.50 annually thereafter for ten years
- 25% return to aid
- Meet inflationary rise in costs for operating expenses
- Meet required increases in wages and benefits for career staff and student assistant wages

#### <u>Note</u>


- Very modest initial increase in fee; from \$3/quarter to \$3.50/quarter
- Previously, no increase since 2016 when originally ratified

### TGIF Fee Renewal Reinstatement Spring 2021 Fall 2022 Election

## The Future of TGIF Recap

- Ratified in 2016, expired in Spring 2021, fee no longer collected
- Spring 2021 referendum did not have a high-enough voter turnout to pass (though 2/3rds majority of those voting were in favor)
- Stewarding remaining funds to manage through AY 2022-23 and potentially Fall 2023.
  Annual Student Fees

**TGIF, \$8.00** 

- Future depends on the outcome of fee reinstatement
  - Now Fall 2022; collection not until Fall 2023
- If referendum *fails*...
  - TGIF sunsets in AY 2022-23
- If referendum *passes*...
  - Invest in maximizing grant management efficiency
  - Enhance outreach, partnership, & collaboration
  - Increase grant opportunities
