- Recruits new students to get involved with faculty-mentored research and design projects






History of Conference Funding


- Conference started in Student Affairs in 1990, with support for staff, poster design, database, etc.
- The Undergraduate Research Center formed in 2008 and Tammy Hoyer moved from Student Affairs to URC; Student Affairs continued to co-sponsor and provide part of funding.
- As the size of the conference increases each year, the Library and Global Affairs join as co-sponsors and contribute part of the funding (with UE and SA).
- Partnership with Student Affairs continued until 2019 at which time we were requested to submit funding request to COSAF.

















Clarification of 15% Budget Increase

Reasons for 15% Budget Increase

- Increase in UC Davis services
 - Facility reservation fees
 - Special services fees
 - Labor costs

- Supply Chain/COVID
 - Overall increase in goods and services
 - Increases in shipping costs
 - Decrease in supply

 Unfunded badges would have no negative impact on students conference experience

 Unfunded food would likely reduce the amount of food offered or remove it all together.
