





The Presence of disability is an expression of human diversity.

Nationally 9-11% of higher education students disclose a disability and request accommodation. Experts agree, nearly twice as many students qualify for services.

During the 2023/2024 academic year, 3,511 students were registered with the Student Disability Center. Academic year 2024/2025, to date, 3,785 students are registered with the SDC.








Student Affairs Assessment Data
