STUDENT POSITIONS

Sports Official

- Serve as the representative of the Competitive Sports program at playing sites.
- Enforce all Competitive Sports and University Policies and Procedures
- Direct play according to the rules of the game and departmental policy
- Record Rec Sports game results
- Interpreting and enforcing Rec Sports rules fairly
- Conflict management and problem solving
- Maintain safe and fun environment.

Sports Recorder

- Act as first contact when participants come into/call the office.
- Communicate effectively with Managers, Coordinators, Rec Sports, and Sport Clubs participants.
- Give paperwork to appropriate Manager/Coordinator.
- Inform managers of questions, paperwork turned in, and any important information.
- Enforce all Competitive Sports and University Policies and Procedures
- Provide professional customer service.
- Conflict management and problem solving

STUDENT POSITIONS

Sports Supervisor

- Serve as the liaison between participants and the Competitive Sports Office
- Enforce all Competitive Sports and University Policies and Procedures
- Direct play according to the rules of the game and departmental policy
- Assist in the training of Rec Sports Officials at clinics.
- Supervise, direct, and evaluate Rec Sports officials
- Record Rec Sports game results and official's work hours
- Serve as the on-site point of contact for Sport Club practices and events
- Perform roster checks for student athletes attending practice

Sports Manager

- Manage Rec Sports teams; recruit, train, and evaluate officials.
- Provide professional customer service to all Rec Sports participants and Sport Club members
- Actively communicate to participants and club members via meetings, trainings, and email
- Prepare indicators and reports for assigned activities
- Hold regular hours in the office and on the field
- Give presentations to team managers and officials
- Understand all policies and procedures as they relate to both programs
- Serve as the liaison between participants and the Competitive Sports Office
