Q3. Please provide a detailed description and purpose of the event/ program.

The GradPathways Institute for Professional Development provides workshops, symposia, and trainings for UC Davis graduate students to prepare them for success in graduate school and their future careers. We host over 150 events per year in support of graduate student development. These events are based on 8 core competencies (see https://gradpathways.ucdavis.edu for details). The funding received from COSAF allows us to continue to provide these events to graduate students in all programs. Last year, we and our campus partners served approximately 12,000 graduate students (not unique individuals). Last year, we received \$13,000 from COSAF in support of our room reservations. We anticipate needing less funding this year and are requesting \$11,000. Our numbers are based on our 2018-19 expenditures. Accordingly, we are submitting our budget based on last year's (2018-19) room reservation documented expenditures.
