

Student Programming Fund Orientation

The Council on Student Affairs and Fees (COSAF) oversees annual funding of up to \$100,000 to support student programs on campus. All campus units that provide co-curricular student services and support for student groups are eligible to apply for one-time funding.

The COSAF Student Programming Fund subcommittee is charged with reviewing each application and determining edibility based on this criteria:

- *Services and programs of growing interest to students*
- *Programs that provide crucial services to students*
- *Student services and programs fostering diversity, equity and inclusion*
- *Programs and activities that benefit a large range of the student population*

Following is the application cycle:

- Applications open during summer, with a close date of early October.
- A second call for applications opens in early December and closes early February.
- The COSAF subcommittee concludes their review in mid-February.
- Applications that qualify, present to the council during Winter and Spring quarters.
- Once COSAF has heard all presentations, the full Council will provide their comments via a Qualtrics survey.
- During Spring quarter, the subcommittee will then review the feedback and deliberate on final award amounts for each application. **Funding applies to the following academic year.**

Based on our subcommittee review this year, the following applications have moved forward in the process and will begin presenting to COSAF today and in upcoming meetings.
