

# Student Programming Fund Orientation

The Council on Student Affairs and Fees (COSAF) oversees annual funding of up to \$100,000 to support student programs on campus. All campus units that provide co-curricular student services and support for student groups are eligible to apply for one-time funding.

The COSAF Student Programming Fund subcommittee is charged with reviewing each application and determining eligibility based on the following criteria:

- *Services and programs of growing interest to students*
- *Programs that provide crucial services to students*
- *Student services and programs fostering diversity, equity and inclusion*
- *Programs and activities that benefit a large range of the student population*

Application cycle:

- Applications have two cycles: **Early Fall** and **Early Winter**
- Applications that qualify present to the council during Winter and Spring quarters
- Once COSAF has heard all presentations, the full Council will provide their comments via a Qualtrics survey.
- The subcommittee will then review the survey feedback and deliberate on final award amounts.  
***Funding applies to the following academic year.***
