




Students Served by Class Standing






About 300 students attended our 32 unique programs.









As a result of this retreat, I feel a greater sense of connectedness to/within a Women of Color community.




As a result of this retreat, I feel affirmed in my intersecting identities.





As a result of this retreat, I feel empowered to define and be who I am.
